**ALL PARTICIPANTS NEED TO BE AT THE STAGING AREA BY 8:30
WE WILL LEAVE THE STAGING AREA AT 9:45 TO
START MARCHING TOWARD HWY. 9**

The staging area will be in the San Lorenzo Lumber Co. parking lot. Parade entrants have to enter the staging area from Graham Hill Road. When the parade begins, participants will go through Henry Cowell State Park to Hwy. 9, proceed through downtown Felton, to the main stop light.

STAGING AREA INSTRUCTIONS:

There will be two people with orange vests at the small booth to tell you which row you are in, what number you are, who you are in front of and who is behind you.

There will be monitors for each row also in orange vests. If you have a problem with your placement, please tell the monitor.

Any car that is not in the parade will not be allowed beyond the dotted line on the map. If you are dropping off parade participants, please do so quickly because the area becomes congested.

DURING AND AT THE END OF THE PARADE:

At the stop light, marchers will disperse to either side of the sidewalk; vehicles will take the right hand turn onto Graham Hill Road.

NO ONE is to stop in the right hand lane before turning onto Graham Hill Road to let people off. Please continue around the corner onto Covered Bridge Road (behind New Leaf Market) to let people off or meet parents, etc.

Please do not let gaps develop between your unit and the one ahead of you. People think the parade is over and start leaving.

The MC is located near the Felton Community Hall at Kirby St. If you would like to do a demonstration & hear your announcement during the parade. PLEASE STOP IN FRONT OF THE STAGE so that there will be enough time.
